Membership Requirements

Dual Role Fire & EMS Providers

Applicants who desire to become Dual Role Fire & EMS personnel must meet the following requirements:

- 1. You must be 18 years of age.
- 2. You must volunteer a minimum of 42 hours each month.
- 3. Dual Role Fire/EMS Providers must complete 48 hours of recognized training each year.
- 4. Minimum training requirements are Firefighter II, Hazardous Materials Operations, Emergency Vehicle Operations, Basic Pumps and Emergency Medical Technician Basic within two years of acceptance.
- 5. Must complete National Incident Management System (NIMS) IS-100, IS-200, IS-700 and IS-800 within three months of acceptance.

Single Function EMS Providers

Applicants who desire to become Single Function EMS Providers must meet the following requirements:

- 1. You must be 18 years of age.
- 2. You must volunteer a minimum of 42 hours each month.
- 3. Single Function EMS Providers must complete 48 hours of recognized training each year.
- 4. Minimum training requirements are Emergency Medical Technician Basic, Emergency Vehicle Operations and Hazardous Materials Awareness within two years of acceptance.
- 5. Must complete National Incident Management System (NIMS) IS-100, IS-200, IS-700 and IS-800 within three months of acceptance.
